We are being sent by Gospel Community and the Fellowship of Evangelical Churches. Additionally we will be partnering with the Southern Baptist Convention and Neighborlink. Between these four ministries we have deep relationships, seasoned accountability and a like minded desire to follow Jesus into the city for His fame.

Upon arriving and settling in Portland, Eric will begin preparing to be a school bus driver:) begin meeting with local leaders, start web platforms for Neighborlink, homecityworld.org, and start meeting with a small group of Christians for the sake of the Gospel in Portland.

Please continue to pray with us as we are committed to learning the culture of Greater Portland and listening to the leadership of the LORD so as to best serve Greater Portland's 7 cities, 61 towns and dozens of neighborhoods with the simple, yet profound, news of Jesus.
