November 1991 after 6 years as missionaries with the Fellowship of Evangelical Churches (FEC) to the Dominican Republic, Jeff and Mary and their children, Sara and Micah, ages 7 and 5, moved to Basque Country. For six years they developed relationships with people in their small town in the heart of Basque country, Lazkao, Spain (population 5,000). The Shadowens returned to the States in 1998; their hearts never far from Basque Country.

In 2008 God opened the door for Jeff and Mary to return to ministry in Basque Country. For the first few years back, they had significant involvement in the Summer in the USA English Immersion program, their local Spanish church, and with other International Workers (missionaries).

Currently the Shadowens are living in Basque country and involved in a variety of ministry opportunities focused on establishing reproducing communities of Christ followers among the Basque people. Their current ministry involvements include: multiplication discipleship training, Church Planting Movement Training, partnering with local evangelical church leaders for expanded ministry in the Basque region, mentoring a Basque Initiative Intern, developing relationships with Basque folks and much more.

A key component to establishing the church among the Basque is prayer. Jeff and Mary have been involved in numerous prayer initiatives for the Basque.
