

Worship Director/Pastor

Job Description

Reports to: Senior Pastor

General: Staff member who oversees all aspects of Worship at Evermore

Qualifications: The Worship Director/Pastor will be a person committed to following Jesus Christ in their daily life. They will live in faithful, growing relationships with his own family, immediate relatives, neighbors, and the church family of ECC.

Possesses strong leadership, communication and relationship skills; must be a team player that is able and willing to work well with the rest of the Pastors, Staff and Congregational Leaders; has a well-rounded knowledge of Biblical truth as understood from an Anabaptist/Evangelical perspective as outlined in the Evermore Community Church Statement of Faith and has a God-given burden and passion to make disciples.

Typical duties and general responsibilities/tasks including, but not limited to:

- Possess a unique musical talent and ability to lead others into true spiritual worship of God.
- With the Lead Pastor, guide the planning, organization and execution of a cohesive, meaningful and integrated Sunday morning worship service that edifies and encourages the Body of Christ.
- Oversee all aspects of the Sunday morning worship service except the sermon message.
- Tech oversight
- Recruit, equip, guide and effectively deploy and harmonize the gifts and talents of volunteer teams including musicians, singers, technicians and other contributors who serve on a worship team at Evermore.
- Contribute to and foster a worship team culture focused on magnifying the Lord and His name, while humbly drawing others into a posture of authentic worship.
- Coordinate with the Youth Pastor to ensure young musical talent in the church is advanced and developed.
- General pastoral: weddings, funerals, teaching, counseling, outreach, mission, etc.
